




 \bigcirc is an original typeface designed by Joseph Soul to represent his personal style and aesthetic view based on the beauty of early 20th century architecture and industrialized style, Art Deco, Streamline Moderne and Organic Architecture. \bigcirc is a very narrow, skinny typeface with extremely wide circles. By using only the geometric curves and lines following the rule of thirds, \bigcirc shows off its elegance and sculptural construction. In this typeface, bowls never connect with straight lines on one side, left-right diagonal lines clear the right side, and multiple overshoot lines occur when two straight lines meet. \bigcirc should not be used smaller then 12pt in print and 14pt on screen.
